17	Salvation apart from effort	Look and live at serpent in wilderness	Look and Live (John 3 and cross)
18	Liberation from the bondage	from slavery	from our sin
19	Given New Life	10 tribes not, 2 tribes returned from Babylon, but incomplete	Resurrection
