Guideline #1 – God's Spirit determines the gift(s)

1 Corinthians 12:11 (MSG) 11 All these gifts have a common origin, but are handed out one by one by the one Spirit of God. He decides who gets what, and when.



## Guideline #2 - The gifts are for the benefit of others

Ephesians 4:11-13 (ESV) 11 And he gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the pastors and teachers, 12 to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, 13 until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ,



## Guideline #3 – Love is the result of the gifts in the church

Romans 12:9-10 (ESV) 9 Let love be genuine. Abhor what is evil; hold fast to what is good. 10 Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor.
